Dear Parents

The new session has started and our children are participating in the academic and co-curricular activities as per the monthly planner sent earlier. We would like to inform you that Central Board of Secondary Education C.B.S.E has framed a new grading system with a C.C.E Scheme (Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation) which aims at the holistic assessment of each student. Our school will follow the CBSE curriculum and guidelines.

Evaluation in this system shall be done in both Scholastic and Co-Scholastic areas spread over two terms. **First Term** will be from **April – September** and **Second Term** from **October - March** and students will be allotted grades.

Scholastic Areas

Each of the two terms will comprise of F.A (Formative Assessment) and S.A (Summative Assessment) which will assess student's performance in the subjects i.e, **English, Math, Science and Technology, Social Science and II Language.**

- Formative Assessments will be made on the active involvement of students in their learning through unit tests and activities like conversations, interviews, quizzes, oral testing, projects, presentations, practicals, class-work, home-work, assignments etc.
- Summative Assessment will be the terminal assessment of performance that shall be conducted at the end of each term. These will be held in the month of September 2010 and then March 2011. Term tests are based on learning units taught during that particular term only.
- First term : FA 1 + FA 2 + SA 1 = 40%
(10%) (10%) (20%)
- Second term : FA 3 + FA 4 + SA 2 = 60%
(10%) (10%) (40%)

The grading scale for this Scholastic Domain is a nine point grading scale.

Students will also be assessed for Work **Experience, Art Education and Physical and Health Education** as well. The assessment will be on a five point grading scale along with Descriptive Indicators.

Co-Scholastic Areas

Co-Scholastic Areas are where participants are assessed in:

Life Skills

Life Skills will be evaluated under thinking skills, Social Skills and Emotional Skills which can be helpful in problem solving and decision making. Students will be assessed on a five point grading scale along with Descriptive Indicators.

Attitudes and Values

Evaluation of Attitudes and Values will be on a three point grading scale with Descriptive Indicators.



These will highlight students' attitude towards **(a) Teachers (b) School mates (c) School programmes (d) Environment (e) Value Systems**

Co-Curricular activities

Co-curricular activities will be graded on the choice of any two activities from **(a) Literary and Creative skills (b) Scientific skills (c) Aesthetic and Performing Art (d) Eco club, Health and Wellness club**. Students will be assessed on their level of participation and achievement on a three point grading scale along with Descriptive Indicators.

Physical and Health Education

Health and Physical Education: - The assessment will be made on any two different kinds of sports and health related activities, on a three point grading scale. The grading will have inputs through descriptive indicators as well.

Students need to make two choices out of the following Co-curricular Activities (one each out of A and B) for assessment in section 3A :

A

Literary and Creative skills

- i. English public speaking and Theatre
- ii. Hindi public speaking and Theatre

Scientific Skills

- iii. Science and Electronic Club
- iv. Math Club

B

Aesthetic and Performing Art Skills

- i. Fine Art and Aesthetic Club
- ii. Music Club (Vocal and Instrumental)
- iii. Dance Club (Indian and Western)

Other Clubs

- iv. Eco Club
- v. Health and Wellness Club
- vi. Connoisseurs Club

Since continuous and comprehensive evaluation will be based on the students' performance throughout the year, parents are requested to advice their wards to take these activities sincerely.
