


## KINDERGARTEN GRADUATION DAY

The moment when the young graduates of Blooms threw their caps high up in the air will certainly remain etched in the memory of the parents and teachers alike for years to come.








## ORIENTATION PROGRAMME




## ANNUAL EXHIBITION

Today, when we see women like PT Usha, Saina Nehwal, Vinita Bali, Kalpana Chawla and Kumud Srinivasan, we realize that the perception of women being incapable has changed. At a United Nations conference on the agenda “The Value of Hosting Mega Sport Events as a Social, Economic and Environmental Sustainable Development Tool”, Laksmi Puri –UN women deputy executive director rightly pointed out that “Sport has a huge potential to empower women and girls”. In addition, Dipa Karmakar became the first Indian female ever to book an Olympic spot in the apparatus events and an all-around event at the Olympic Test Event. This empowerment of women has opened up many new and exciting avenues for them in the world of sports.


**विपदाओं से मुझे बचाओ, यह मेरी प्रार्थना नहीं,

# PEDAGOGY



‘Pedagogy’ refers to what teachers do and how they do it in the classroom. The methodology of teaching can be seen as directly linked with positive student learning outcome. At Sachdeva Global School, students are not seen as passive vessels to be filled but active constructors in the process of teaching and learning. The teaching practices at SGS help foster holistic development, individuality and confidence within the students.

## Experiential Learning

‘Experiential Learning’ refers to the process of learning via ‘experience’ and ‘doing’. Kolb’s cycle of ‘Experiential learning’ is central to this notion, which involves the stage of personal reflection (abstract conceptualization) after a new experience, following which the learner tries to implement that which he/she has learned (active experimentation). This leads to newer experiences and the cycle continues.

**SGS faculty helps in creating meaningful experiences for students, and inspires them to actively reflect, thus creating long – lasting and effective learning.**



## Problem Based Learning (PBL)

Problem Based Learning is a dynamic approach to teaching involving exposing of students to real word problems and challenges and motivating them to explore. The aim of this active and engaged learning is to inspire students to have a deeper understanding of the subjects learnt. The additional benefits include the inculcation of various life skills of planning, organizing, teaming and tasking.



## Role play and Summarizations

Active, interactive theme based story telling sessions and role play is an integral feature of classroom teaching at SGS. Lessons taught are summarized on a fortnightly or monthly basis, where the entire class participates in a role play to dramatize and present the concept.



## FACULTY DEVELOPMENT

In addition to pedagogical innovations, we at SGS also believe in the importance of professional development of the teaching staff.

The mighty bounds of austerity are completely bind.



